

CARL LEONARD HUSSEY, P.E.

After completing twelve years of service, Mr. Carl L. Hussey, P.E., retired in December 2007 from his duties as the Utility Coordinator for the Roadway Production Division of the Engineering & Public Works Department, an agency of the Palm Beach County government. In this capacity, Mr. Hussey assisted the Division that is responsible for executing Palm Beach County's strategy with regard to Roadway Improvements under the 5 Year Road Program as adopted by the Municipal Planning Organization, a partnership between several of the Municipalities and Palm Beach County. His recommendations for orderly relocation of affected municipal and privately owned utilities in relation to the Division's roadway construction priorities facilitated the work improvement process.

Previously, as a twenty year veteran of the Florida Power & Light (FPL) Company, he worked on various design and engineering activities. FPL is the leading investor owned electrical utility within the State of Florida and a subsidiary of the FPL Group.

Mr. Hussey is the Division VII PACE Coordinator and also serves as the Power Engineering Society's (PES) PACE Chairman. He maintains an active PES role as a multi-term Chairman for the PES Chapter within the Palm Beach Section. He also serves as the Educational Activities Committee Chairman to the Florida Council of the IEEE, the Area 5 entity which is a subset of Region 3, the geographic area representing members within the Southeastern portion of the United States. He was recently appointed as a coordinator for Region 3 to the IEEE-USA Employment and Career Services Committee.

He holds an A.A. Degree in Engineering from Palm Beach Community College, a B.S. Degree in Science from Florida Atlantic University, and an MBA from Nova/Southeastern University (NSU) with a specialization certificate in Human Resource Management.
