For over 25 years, Gregg has maintained a profitable engineering consulting practice, and for over 33 years he has been an engineering educator. Since 1995 he has served as Chair of the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering of the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) and from 1979 to 1995 he was an Associate Professor at UAB.
