

## STEVE CZUCHLEWSKI

Steve grew up in New York City and received a Ph.D. in physics from Yale University. He has retired from Los Alamos National Laboratory after 30-years of service as a Technical Staff Member. He played lead roles in the design and testing of high-energy (10 kJ) CO<sub>2</sub> and KrF lasers for inertial-confinement fusion. He has had a long-term affiliation with the IEEE Lasers and Electro-Optics Society (LEOS). At LANL he also conducted research on electron-beam propagation, remote sensing and hydrodynamics.

As the 2006 IEEE Engineering and Diplomacy Fellow, Steve served at the State Department in the Nonproliferation Office of the European and Eurasian Bureau. He was the bureau's primary interface to the DOE Defense and Nuclear Nonproliferation Programs. Steve is the chairman of the Los Alamos Community Health-Care Roundtable and is a member of several citizen-based Arms-Control groups.
