To honor members of the engineering profession for long-term dedicated effort and outstanding accomplishments in advancing the aims of IEEE professional activities in the United States.	Specially engraved plaque; one annually
IEEE-USA Award for Distinguished Contributions to Public Service.	To honor individuals not currently in the practice of engineering for contributions to furthering the professional goals of IEEE in the United States. (These goals may be furthered by such means as promulgating laws or regulations benefiting the profession, influencing industrial environments to foster professionalism; creating curricula or publications designed to enhance professionalism; and other similar activities.)	Specially engraved plaque; one annually
IEEE-USA Citation of Honor	To honor members who have made exemplary contributions toward achieving the aims of professional activities in the United States.	Specially engraved maximum of four annually
IEEE-USA Regional or Divisional Professional Leadership Award	To recognize members for their outstanding leadership efforts in advancing the professional aims of IEEE in the United States within their Regional or Divisional/ Society entities.	Engraved plaque; maximum of ten annually
IEEE-USA Professional Achievement Award	To recognize significant specific contributions, achievements and individual and organizational efforts in the development and implementation of professional activities in the United States.	Engraved plaque; as warranted by suitable specific accomplishments
