# ***INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING THE NOMINATION PACKAGE:***

## **Distinguished Literary Contributions Furthering Public Understanding of the Profession**

*Basis of the Award:* Submissions will be judged on their quality in portraying subjects, themes, or incidents, or on their editorial content. They may include an individual presentation or a series of presentations that lead to a better public understanding of the contributions of engineering professionals to the enhancement and expansion of social, economic, and cultural components of life. Submission will be limited to print and broadcast media, produced by groups other than professional engineering organizations in the United States.

*Nominations:* Nominations may be submitted by the author(s); publisher, editor, radio, or television station responsible for the effort, or by any interested individual.

### *Supporting Documentation:*

1. Complete identification of the distinguished contribution made by the candidate(s), including title(s), place and date of publication or location and time presented.
2. Describe the aspects of the literary effort which make it distinguished. Include a 300- to 500- word summary of what the basic subject of the work is and why the piece meets the objectives of this award in an outstanding way. In addition, include a copy of the piece itself or a tape, transcripts, or other reasonable evidence of presentation. The printed piece(s) or broadcast presentation(s) must have been published, aired, or heard in the calendar year preceding the submission.
3. Biography of the candidate(s), including any recognition or honors accorded.
4. Any additional endorsements desired.

## **Distinguished Literary Contributions Furthering Engineering Professionalism**

*Basis of the Award:* Consideration will be given to the quality of the piece and the contributions made by the author as a result of a singular important literary effort, or as the result of contributions over a period of time or a career that has included numerous contributions which, taken as a whole, reflect effort to communicate successfully and enhance engineering professionalism in appropriate areas of concern such as economics, ethics, legislation, and social and technology policy.

*Nominations:* Nominations may be submitted by the author(s); publisher, radio, or television station responsible for the effort, or by any interested individual.

### *Supporting Documentation:*

1. Complete identification of the distinguished literary contribution(s) made by the candidate(s), including title(s), place and date of publication or location and time presented.
2. Describe the aspects of the literary effort which make it distinguished. Include a summary of what the basic subject of the work is and why the piece meets the objectives of this award in an outstanding way. If the nomination is to recognize numerous contributions during the course of a career that have successfully communicated and enhanced the engineering profession, provide extensive description of those specific contributions and activities that support such a nomination.
3. Biography of the candidate(s), including any recognition or honors accorded.
4. Any additional endorsements or evidence desired.
